



At this time, we are accepting resumes for the position of **Operations Superintendent**.

Accountable to the Regional Manager for operating, repairing and servicing the location farm supply equipment, regulation compliance and assist the branch manager with coordinating the operations staff in the region.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

Maintenance

- Manages and maintains equipment for the regional farm supply in accordance with the regional Preventative Maintenance Plan.
- Works with the Regional Manager in determining and performing the rolling stock repairs and service needs.
- Provides recommendations and/or advises the Regional Manager with asset upgrading requirements (structural design, maintenance, equipment and procedures) that will enhance the operations of the region.

Operations & Quality Control

- Unloads the products received from the various suppliers, verifying the load meets the requirements of the location in terms of quality of the product and the quantity purchased.
- Loads packaged goods products using a forklift, but may require lifting or rolling the products onto the truck.
- Monitors the level of the product to avoid unnecessary spills and bleeds the lines once the wagons are full.
- Blends and loads fertilizer and chemicals in accordance with blend sheets and customer's agronomic program.
- Ensures sufficient supply of fertilizer blending ingredient in the bins.
- Sets up application equipment in the yard as well as the field at the grower's request.
- Receives, prepares and ships chemicals, fertilizer and seed in inventory in accordance with safety and environmental precautions.
- Responsible completing all permits for the region including work safe work plans, confined space, fumigation and hot work (cutting and welding).
- Assisting the regional manager with staff procurement, performance management training needs.
- Leads the audit processes (AWSA, CSI, EH&S).

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma, must achieve and maintain job specific required licenses
- 3-5 years relevant experience
- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs.
